LATAM FLIGHT

ITINERARY 2 PERSONS

21. DEC. 2019 - 04. JAN. 2020



### Saturday 21 – Sunday 22 Dec. 2019

Arrive at Mount Pleasant International Airport via LATAM flight. Personal meet and greet by Falkland Islands holiday representative and transfer to **Stanley** to the Malvina Hotel. 1 night Standardroom B&B. Visit the newly located museum just opposite the hotel.

**All flight times on FIGAS will be notified the day prior to departure. Baggage allowance on FIGAS is 20kg per person. Excess is charged at £1.40 per kilo per flight and is payable at Stanley airport prior to your departure.**

### Sunday 22 – Tuesday 24 Dec. 2019

Transfer to the airstrip for your internal flight to **Bleaker Island**. The relatively low level flying provides passengers with exceptional views of the Falklands coastlines and inland scenery. 2 night's accommodation on a full board basis. Bleaker Island is a smaller and flatter island, offers easy walking to wildlife locations, pond areas and beaches. However, a familiarization tour is included to show you where the wildlife spots are. Cormorant and Rockhopper penguins only minutes walk from the Lodge. **Vehicle hire available – please ask on arrival.**

### Tuesday 24 – Friday 27 Dec. 2019

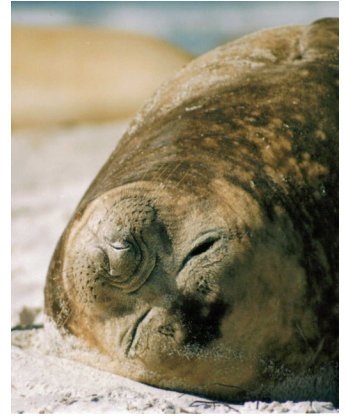
Transfer to the airstrip for your internal flight to **Carcass Island**. 3 night's accommodation at the Lodge on a full board basis. Carcass hosts an array of wildlife, Cobb's wren and Tussock birds, penguins and Striated Caracara to name but a few - to the west of the island Elephant seals can be found.

Full day boat trip to **West Point Island** is included – take to the seas on 'Seaquest' and sail the short distance to the settlement at West Point – you will be joined by Commerson's dolphins trying to race the boat and maybe the odd seal. Once ashore you will be taken to the large colony of breeding Black-browed Albatross. Packed lunch provided.

### Friday 27 Dec. - Monday 30 Dec. 2019

Internal flight to **Pebble Island** for 3 night's FB at Pebble Lodge. Included 2 full day tours to see the wildlife and also a little history with your driver/guide.

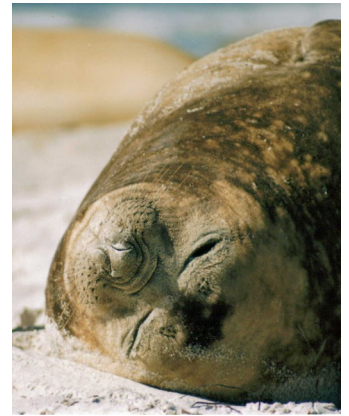
Pebble Island is one of the larger outlying islands, the landscape varies greatly from large ponds and moorland, to sandy beaches and rocky cliffs. This diverse countryside offers shelter and protection to an equally wide-ranging breeding population of birds and mammals. Many thousands of Gentoo, Rockhopper and Magellanic penguins breed each summer along with raucous congregations of Southern sea lions. The ponds on the east of the island are home to Chiloe wigeon, Grebes, Black-necked swans and a multitude of other wildfowl and wading birds. The tours offer ample opportunity to see the abundant wildlife and spectacular scenery further afield from the settlement, as well as hunting for the semiprecious stones that give the island its name. Pebble has something for the historian with some 1982 debris and the memorial to the HMS Coventry.



### Monday 30 Dec. - Thursday 02 Jan. 2020

Transfer for your internal flight to **Sea Lion Island**. Meet and transfer to the lodge for 3 night's accommodation on a full board basis. Orientation tour is included with driver/guide.

Sea Lion Island is the most southerly inhabited island and one of the smallest in the Falklands archipelago, but it is still a prime destination due to the sheer abundance of wild life found in such a small area. 47 different species of breeding birds make their home on Sea Lion Island, including the endangered Striated Caracara, Antarctic skuas, Southern giant petrels, and a host of passerines. Birds are not the only wildlife here! Southern sea lions play in the waters around East Loafers, and the Elephant seals bask on the white sandy beach at the appropriately named Elephant Corner. If you keep your eyes open, you may be fortunate enough to see a killer whale off shore as well.



### Thursday 02 Jan. – Saturday 04 Jan 2020

Transfer for internal flight to **Stanley** and Transfer overland in 4 x 4 vehicle to **Volunteer Point** with your driver/guide. After passing Johnsons Harbour you will reach Volunteer Beach, this is home to the large colony of breeding King penguins, Gentoo and Magellanic. Many shore birds and the odd seal! 2 night's accommodation FB in the Warden's cottage. Volunteer Point is a NO smoking area.



### Saturday 04 Jan. 2020

Transfer overland in 4 x 4 vehicle to Mount Pleasant International Airport for your return LATAM flight. Your transfer time will be advised the night prior to your departure. Please note that £25 departure tax is payable to Immigration before boarding. Cash only.
